INVITATION

Dear Colleagues,

The next event of the "Ear and Sinus Surgery Workshop - 2025", marking the Silver Jubilee (25th edition), will be held in Nashik from 20th to 25th August 2025. We are excited to announce that this year, the workshop will be hosted for the first time at the new, state-of-the-art Indorewala ENT Hospital at Vilholi, Nashik.

Since we can accommodate only 100 delegates and seats tend to fill up quickly, we are publishing the dates well in advance for the convenience of those who wish to attend.

The course is designed in such a way that both basic and advanced surgeries are thoroughly addressed, making it highly beneficial for beginners as well as experienced surgeons. Surgeries of the ear and nose are presented as a fine blend of science and art.

We offer hands-on wet temporal bone and cadaveric endoscopic sinus dissections for delegates, with close supervision and individual attention from our faculty. The temporal bone dissection course will guide delegates through every step - from how to hold the dissection specimen, correct sitting posture during dissection, cortical mastoidectomy, labyrinthectomy, to translabyrinthine approach for the internal auditory meatus - without skipping anything in between. The basic dissection will span two days, with each delegate having their own wet specimen.

Similarly, the endoscopic sinus dissection will cover everything from the fundamentals of endoscope handling to advanced steps like ethmoidectomy, frontal recess approach, and skull base exposure, again ensuring no step is missed. Each delegate will have their own wet specimen for this as well.

The two days of dissection will be followed by two days of live surgical demonstrations, showcasing a wide range of procedures. As always, the organizers' focus will remain pure in intention, approach, and implementation. The spirit of academics, along with practical surgical tips and techniques, will guide these eventful days.

Registrations for the workshop will open from 1st June 2025 onwards.

Shabbir Indorewala: From Nashik, India. Consultant & MD of Indorewala ENT Institute, accredited by College of Physicians & Surgeon, Mumbai for DORL and by MUHS for Fellowship in Otology for PG students. He is built Asia's largest ENT hospital in Nashik. He has recipient of RAF Cooper & AOI-E.Merck Awards. He has developed and popularized concept of Endomeatal Tympanoplasty, Anterior Tympanotomy, Dimensional Stability of Free Fascia Grafts, Closure of tegmen defect & closure of M-M-F with sigmoid plate. His research on fascia was invited for presentation at International Fascia Research Foundation at Harvard University in 2007. He has started fully equipped center for cochlear implant surgery at Nashik since 2009. He has been invited as operating faculty at various ENT forums at many places within the country and abroad. He is passionate about other lateral skull base surgeries. Diagnosed and created awareness for Mucormycosis during the 1st wave of COVID-19, developing treatment protocols. Saved numerous lives through timely interventions, preventing loss of eyes, nose, skull, and life.



THULASI DAS

DR.P.THULASI DAS, passed MS(ENT) in 1982 and M.Ch (Plastic) in 1987. He received the Dr.P.V.Cherian endowment prize for being the best out going student in MS(ENT). Currently he is a consultant at Apollo Hospitals, Chennai. He is the founder, member and secretary of the SESI. He has published 18 research papers and delivered 31 quest orations. He has been moderator and a panelist in many panel discussions. He has conducted 32 workshops as a guest and host faculty. His video on "Endoscopic Tear sign & DCR" won a bronze medal in the World congress of Otorhinolaryngology in Sydney, Australia in 1997. He won a gold medal for a video on "Endoscopic Reconstruction of CSF fistulae" in the IX World Congress of International Rhinologic societies held in Washington DC in 2000. The first ever Endoscopic Sinus surgery in Chennai was done by him at Chennai in 1990. The first ever Endoscopic Optic Nerve decompression and Orbital Decompress in India was done by him in 1992. The first ever Endoscopic plugging of CSF rhinorrhoea, in South India was done by him in 1994. The first ever Endoscopic Hypophysectomy in Chennai was done by him in 1995. He has the largest number of Endoscopic DCRs in the country to his credit.
