After 25 successful years of conducting the Annual Ear and Sinus Surgery Workshop, we are delighted to announce the upcoming 26th edition, to be held in Nashik from 11th to 16th February 2026.

This year, the workshop will once again be hosted at the new, state-of-the-art **Indorewala ENT Hospital, Vilholi, Nashik in collaboration with SMBT Institute, Nashik**. Since we can accommodate only 100 delegates and seats tend to fill up quickly, we are sharing the dates well in advance for the convenience of those who wish to attend. The course is structured to comprehensively cover both basic and advanced surgeries, making it equally valuable for beginners and experienced surgeons alike. Surgeries of the ear and nose will be presented as a fine blend of science and art.

Delegates will benefit from hands-on wet temporal bone and cadaveric endoscopic sinus dissections, conducted under close supervision with individual attention from our esteemed faculty. The temporal bone dissection course will guide delegates step by step- from specimen handling and proper posture to cortical mastoidectomy, labyrinthectomy, and the translabyrinthine approach to the internal auditory meatus- ensuring no step is missed.

Each participant will receive their own wet specimen. Similarly, the endoscopic sinus dissection course will begin with the fundamentals of endoscope handling and progress to advanced techniques such as ethmoidectomy, frontal recess approach, and skull base exposure. Once again, each delegate will have their own wet specimen. Following the two days of dissection, there will be two days of live surgical demonstrations, showcasing a wide range of procedures.

As always, the organizers remain committed to maintaining the highest standards of academic excellence while providing practical surgical insights and techniques. Registrations for the workshop will open on 15th November 2025.
